H) THE FOUNDING OF FULNECK



In 1744 the Moravians moved into some of the cottages on the land, holding church services in a converted barn, now a family house. In 1746 the foundation of the church was laid and the building was completed in 1748.

Along the ridge of the valley, overlooking the woods and fields, Fulneck began to spread. Just as in Herrnhut, the residents lived together in groups, giving them that feeling of security and

togetherness which created a close community.

In 1751 the house for the single sisters was built to the east of the church and the single brethrens' house was built to the west. It was in these two centres that much of the trade and industry would take place as it was essential that everyone worked to earn money to support themselves.
